

Daily Activities/Services Tickets and Gift Certificates Purchase, Exchange, Refund Terms and Conditions Offer and Sochi Autodrom Visiting Rules

This Daily Activities tickets and gift certificates purchase, exchange, refund terms and conditions public offer and Rules and Sochi Autodrom visiting rules (hereinafter referred to as the “Offer”) have been drawn up in accordance with Paragraph 2 Article 437 of the Civil Code of the Russian Federation and applies to any Ticket and/or Gift Certificate Customer wishing to purchase Tickets and/or Gift Certificates for Daily Activities held at Sochi Autodrom and any Ticket Holder.

This Offer establishes the Daily Activity Ticket and Gift Certificate purchase, exchange and refund terms and conditions, as well as the rights and obligations of the Ticket Holders when visiting Sochi Autodrom as part of the activities to which they have purchased Tickets.

Any Ticket and/or Gift Certificate Customer, Ticket Holder, Gift Certificate Holder is strongly recommended to read and observe the terms and conditions of this Offer. By purchasing a Ticket or a Gift Certificate, by visiting Sochi Autodrom (entering or being), each Ticket and/or Gift Certificate Customer, Ticket Holder, Gift Certificate Holder accepts the terms and conditions of this Offer and agrees that all the terms and conditions of this Offer and any obligations related to it are binding.

1. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

1.1. For the purpose of literal interpretation of this Offer the following definitions are set:

“Offer Terms and Conditions” means the terms and conditions, set out in this Offer that can be amended or modified from time to time, including but not limited publications on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website. And if the Terms and Conditions of the Offer change the Promoter shall publish the new version of the Offer on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website at https://sochiautodrom.ru/Documents/Offer_Daily_activities_2020_en.pdf without notifying the Ticket and/or Gift Certificate Customer/Holder of it additionally.

“Promoter”/“Organiser” means Autonomous non-profit organisation “ROSGONKI” (ANO “ROSGONKI”), TIN 7730240248, PSRN 1177700021388, registered at 13 Barklaya St., Building 2, 3rd Floor, Office 1, Moscow 121309.

“Sochi Autodrom Official Website” means a combination of information resources located in the Internet at sochiautodrom.ru and published by the Promoter for general public with the purpose of providing actual and accurate information on the services provided at Sochi Autodrom.

“Official Call Centre” means a centre performing the functions of selling Tickets and redeeming Gift Certificates against Ticket(s), as well as providing customer support to Ticket and/or Gift Certificate Customers by email at callcenter@rosгонki.ru, as well as by phone on 8 800 100 46 86, + 7 (495) 197 77 26 (for international calls).

“Official Ticket Offices” means ticket offices performing on behalf and in the interest of the Promoter the functions of selling Tickets and Gift Certificates and redeeming Gift Certificates against Tickets.

“Daily Activities” means services provided at Sochi Autodrom. A detailed list and description of the Daily Activities is available on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website.

“Sochi Autodrom” means the circuit for automobile road races of the Formula 1 series in the Imeretinskaya Lowland and infrastructure facilities that ensure its operation located in the Adler District of the city of Sochi (hereinafter referred to as the Circuit).

“Ticket Customer” means an individual and/or an entity who has applied to the Promoter or an entity representing the Promoter’s interests (“Designated Seller of Tickets”) to purchase, get issued, exchange, get a refund for a Ticket and/or Gift Certificate or who has purchased a Ticket/or Gift Certificate himself/herself via the Sochi Autodrom Official Website.

“Ticket Product Consumer” means the person who actually owns the Ticket and has the rights to receive services in accordance with the Ticket purchased, including the Ticket Customer.

“Gift Certificate Holder” means the person who actually owns the Gift Certificate and has the right to redeem it for a Ticket.

“Ticket” means a document generated in electronic form by the ticket sales system, containing a unique registered number, a bar code (QR code), other information and certifying the right of the bearer to receive the services of the relevant Ticket. The Ticket is sent in digital form to the email address specified by the Customer.

The Ticket is to be transferred to paper (to be printed) by the Ticket Customer/Ticket Holder themselves or at the Official Ticket Offices based on the payment document.

“Gift Certificate” means a voucher generated in electronic form by the ticket sales system with an open date and a face value valid for 1 (one) year of the payment containing compulsory details set by the Promoter, as well as a unique bar code. The Gift Certificate is sent in digital form to the email address specified by the Customer.

“Ticket Face Value” means an amount corresponding to the amount of funds corresponding to the cost set by the Promoter (or set by the Customer in case of purchasing a Gift Certificate) for all third parties. Information about the set price of Tickets is posted by the Promoter on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website.

“Sochi Autodrom Tours” means an excursion event that includes a visit to Sochi Autodrom and the services of a professional guide.

“Sochi Auto Sport Museum Visit” means an excursion event that includes getting to see the exhibits of Sochi Auto Sport Museum in the Main Grandstand of Sochi Autodrom. The duration of the visit is limited to the opening hours.

“Sochi Autodrom Tour + Sochi Auto Sport Museum Visit” means an excursion event that includes a visit to Sochi Autodrom and the services of a professional guide, and then getting to see the exhibits of Sochi Auto Sport Museum in the Main Grandstand of Sochi Autodrom.

“Sochi Autodrom Track Tour in Golf Cart/Electric Cart” means an excursion event that includes a ride on the Sochi Autodrom track in a six/eight-seat golf cart. The guests accompanied by a guide move along the Sochi Autodrom track and learn the history of Sochi Autodrom and get to know the Olympic Park facilities located along the route. They make one stop to take pictures.

“Race Taxi” means an individual excursion event that includes driving the Ticket Holder as a passenger along the Sochi Autodrom track at a speed that allows the Ticket Holder to get acquainted with the high-speed capabilities of the track.

“Mercedes-AMG Race Taxi” means an individual excursion event that includes driving the Ticket Holder as a passenger along the Sochi Autodrom track at a speed that allows the Ticket Holder to get acquainted with the high-speed capabilities of the track.

“Track Session” means an individual training lesson in motorsport, which includes a 20-minute session on the Sochi Autodrom track in the Customer’s car/other vehicle, or 1 lap on the Sochi Autodrom track in the Customer’s car/other vehicle.

“Master Class” means an individual training lesson in motorsport, which includes a training session prior to the Ticket Holder driving on the Sochi Autodrom track, consisting of 2 laps. During the first lap an instructor who conducts theoretical training for the Ticket Holder is driving, during the second lap the Ticket Holder completes one lap on the track under the instructor’s supervision.

“Mercedes-AMG Master Class” means an individual training lesson in motorsport, which includes a training session prior to the Ticket Holder driving on the Sochi Autodrom track, consisting of 2 laps. During the first lap an instructor who conducts theoretical training for the Ticket Holder is driving, during the second lap the Ticket Holder completes one lap on the track under the instructor’s supervision.

“Extra Lap” means 1 extra lap in a car on the Sochi Autodrom track purchased in addition to the main “Mercedes-AMG Race Taxi”, “Mercedes-AMG Master Class”, “Master Class”, “Race Taxi” Ticket.

“Mercedes-AMG Tour” means an individual excursion event when the Ticket Holder is driven as a passenger at a low speed along the Sochi Autodrom track.

“Mercedes-AMG Experience” means an individual motorsports training session that includes a number of theoretical lectures and practices aimed at the Ticket Holder acquiring specific driving skills.

“Pit Stop Challenge” means a team building event that includes the process of putting on/taking off wheels on a sports car with time being controlled using special tools.

“Drift Master Class” means an individual training session in motorsport that includes training as the co-driver and then the driver under the guidance of a professional instructor in one of the two professionally prepared Nissan Silvia S14 cars.

“Drift Master Class in Customer’s Car” means an individual training session in motorsports, during which the Ticket Holder pays only the cost of renting the training site, without using the services of an instructor.

“Follow the Leader in Mercedes-AMG GTs / Mercedes-AMG GT Car” means an individual training session in motorsports that includes a ride (1 lap) of two crews in Mercedes-AMG GTs / Mercedes-AMG GT cars chasing a professional Sochi Autodrom driver.

“Basic Motorcycle Riding Lesson” means an individual training lesson in motorcycle riding that includes 25 exercises for the development of reaction, motor skills, motorcycle control, correct gaze setting, manoeuvring at low speeds, correct acceleration and deceleration control, manoeuvring in a confined space on a Yamaha motorcycle YBR.

“Advanced Motorcycle Riding Lesson” means a customised motorsport training lesson conducted on BMW motorcycles (S1000rr, S1000r, F800r, 300G, S1000XR range), Ducati Hyper Motard 900, including braking exercises in at different speeds, countersteering, changing riding line, cornering at a high speed.

“Stunt Riding” means individual training lessons in motorsport, including the basic principles of performing stunts (theory), the principles of choosing the motorcycle and its preparation, riding on the rear and on the front wheel.

“Track Training” means an individual training course in motorcycle riding, including defensive riding, track training, motorcycle gymkhana or high-speed manoeuvring in an enclosed space

“Motorcycle Trip” means an individual training course in motorcycle riding that includes a ride on a selected vehicle from the school’s motorcycle fleet with a mountain serpentine instructor to practice the skills acquired on the site.

“Professional Automobile Photography Master Class at Sochi Autodrom” means an event that includes photography of cars at Sochi Autodrom and processing of the resulting photographs in graphics editors under the guidance of an instructor.

“Additional Services” means ancillary services provided in addition to the main Tickets, such as the provision of sports equipment (overalls, helmet, sports shoes, gloves) for rent during the provision of the main service, photography and filming of the process of rendering the main service, others accompanying services.

“Additional Companion at Sochi Autodrom” means a person over the age of 12 who acquires, free of charge or for a fee, the right to access the place of provision of the “Race Taxi”, “Master Class” services, accompanying the Ticket Holder to these daily activities, without the right to participate in these activities.

“Additional Payments” means a service associated with the purchase of a Ticket and/or a Gift Certificate, namely the delivery of the Ticket subject to agreeing it with the Customer of the delivery, service charges may apply.

“Force Majeure” means extraordinary, unavoidable circumstances under the given conditions such as floods, earthquakes, volcanic eruptions, hurricanes, tornadoes, wars and military actions, blockades, epidemics, pandemics, as well as decisions by state and local authorities to cancel, postpone the services provided at Sochi Autodrom.

“Affiliates” means any suppliers, organisers, promoters, entities and persons involved in the organisation, staging and promotion of the services provided at Sochi Autodrom.

“Designated Seller of Tickets” means the status that ANO “ROSGONKI” grants to a seller in respect of ticket sales for the Sochi Autodrom Daily Activities.

1.2. For the purpose of this Offer, except for the cases when the context stipulates otherwise:

- (a) words in the singular shall include the plural, and vice versa;
- (b) words importing a specific gender shall include the other genders (male, female or neuter);
- (c) the headings are for convenience only and shall not affect the interpretation;
- (d) a reference to a “Clause” is a reference to a clause of this Offer;
- (e) reference to the Offer includes all amendments or supplements to this Offer, published on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website.

2. GENERAL CONDITIONS

2.1. In case of adverse weather conditions or force-majeure services provided at Sochi Autodrom may be cancelled in their entirety and/or their part may be postponed or cancelled at the Promoter’s sole discretion. Information about the cancellation or postponement of any services with the exception of the race taxi, the track sessions, the master classes, the Mercedes test drives as part of the AMG Experience project is published by the Promoter on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website.

2.2. The Promoter reserves the right, without notice, to add, withdraw, reschedule or substitute any particular person ensuring the services provided at Sochi Autodrom, group, car, race as part of the services provided at Sochi Autodrom, amend seating arrangements and audience capacity.

2.3. Each Ticket Holder is aware, agrees, accepts and acknowledges that Sochi Autodrom is a dangerous place, the services provided are dangerous and accidents can happen. Each Ticket Holder is warned that there is a possibility of an accident causing injury, death or property damage or loss; visiting Sochi Autodrom is solely at the Ticket Holder’s own risk and the Ticket Holder assumes such risk. Each Ticket Holder acknowledges that the risks associated with visiting Sochi Autodrom includes the risk of suffering harm as a result of motor vehicles (or parts of them) colliding with other motor vehicles, persons or property. Each Ticket Holder agrees, accepts and acknowledges that visiting Sochi Autodrom to get services has a degree of danger and, to the extent permitted by the law of the Russian Federation, hereby releases the Promoter and/or any and all Affiliates from any and all liability for claims, loss, damage, cost or expenses suffered by the Ticket Holder as a result of a personal injury

or death to the extent that this is provided for by the law of the Russian Federation. A Ticket Holder also bears responsibility for Ticket Holders under 18 or children under 6 (having the right to enter without a Ticket) under his/her supervision at Sochi Autodrom, as well as the persons accompanying the Ticket Holder who have received the right to free admission to Sochi Autodrom or who purchase the Additional Companion service at Sochi Autodrom for a fee.

2.4. No goods (including literature) of any nature may be offered either free or for sale by any person within Sochi Autodrom or in a car park by any party, which does not have a proper permit to do so.

2.5. It is forbidden to bring into, use or display within Sochi Autodrom any sponsorship, promotional or marketing materials.

2.6. Where available, the Promoter will provide mobility impaired persons (wheelchair users) in possession of Tickets with appropriate seating. Should such seating be required, the Ticket Customer should contact the Official Call Centre before purchasing a Ticket to discuss the conditions of purchasing a Ticket for this seating category.

Reduced fare tickets for excursion services are provided to veterans, students, large families, pensioners, subject to the provision of an original/a certified copy of document confirming their status. Children under 6, orphans, participants and veterans of the Great Patriotic War, people with disabilities of Groups 1 and 2 are entitled to a free Ticket for excursion services.

2.7. Some areas at Sochi Autodrom are exposed to direct sunlight, rain and wind. Each Ticket Holder should take appropriate care for their well-being and protection from such weather conditions.

2.8. While at Sochi Autodrom, a Ticket Holder must maintain safe, prudent and respectful behaviour and comply with all security measures and instructions given by the Promoter or any other entities acting with the consent of the Promoter.

2.9. Description of the Sochi Autodrom Daily Activities, their date, time, location and prices are provided on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website in the section dedicated to the Daily Activities.

2.10. At certain times, including in relation to certain types of the Daily Activities, and for safety and operational reasons, the Promoter may advise that children do not visit Sochi Autodrom. From time to time the Promoter may prohibit persons under 18 from visiting Sochi Autodrom, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian who is over 18. The protection of any person who is under the care of another, (including any person under 18 is the responsibility of the accompanying parent or guardian. Each Ticket Holder is strongly advised to exercise diligent supervision and extreme caution in respect of the person under 18 when visiting Sochi Autodrom with a person under 18.

2.11. The hire of vehicles and a track session are available only to Ticket Holders over 18 and require a separate agreement to be entered into with the Promoter.

2.12. Race Taxi and Mercedes-AMG Race Taxi are available only to Ticket Holders over 18.

2.13. Master Class is available only to Ticket Holders over 18 who hold a B category driving licence and have passed the medical examination set by the Promoter.

2.14. Mercedes-AMG Master Class is available only to Ticket Holders over 23 who hold a B category driving licence and have passed the medical examination set by the Promoter.

2.15. Follow the Leader in Mercedes-AMG GTs / Mercedes-AMG GT Car is available only to Ticket Holders over 23 who hold a B category driving licence and have passed the medical examination set by the Promoter.

2.16. Mercedes-AMG Experience is available only to Ticket Holders over 23 who hold a B category driving licence and have passed the medical examination set by the Promoter.

3. TERM OF THE OFFER

3.1. This offer applies to the Daily Activities listed in this Offer and held by the Promoter at Sochi Autodrom.

4. PERSONAL DATA

4.1. In accordance with Federal Law No. 152-FZ “On Personal Data” dated 27 July 2006, by accepting this Offer (entering into an agreement) a Ticket Customer agrees that when providing his or her personal data on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website or other internet resource specified on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website, or by disclosing his or her personal data in any other way (at Official Ticket Offices, to call a centre operator, etc.), his or her personal data becomes public.

The Promoter and/or a person authorised by it shall have the right to use public personal data of a Ticket Customer to carry out marketing mailouts and for other purposes, including the purpose of fulfilling obligations to the Ticket Customer in accordance with this Offer.

The provisions of this clause are fully applicable to the Ticket Customers who are not citizens of the European Union. For the Ticket Customers who are citizens of the European Union, the provisions of this clause shall apply to the extent that they do not contradict the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation.

4.2. If Tickets (except for a Gift Certificate) are purchased via the Sochi Autodrom Official Website or other Internet resource specified on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website, the Promoter reserves the right to oblige the Ticket Customer to provide additional information containing personal data, to which the Ticket Customer (except for a Gift Certificate) grants his/her consent.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

5.1. The Parties shall bear responsibility for a failure to perform or improper performance of the obligations under the Offer according to the applicable laws of the Russian Federation.

5.2. The Promoter shall not be responsible for ensuring sufficient Ticket/Gift Certificate inventory across all the price categories and Daily Activities.

5.3. The Promoter shall not be responsible for ensuring the conformity of the services provided at Sochi Autodrom to the expectations of a Ticket Holder.

5.4. The Promoter undertakes to provide accurate and timely information about the services provided at Sochi Autodrom.

5.5. The Promoter shall not be responsible and shall not reimburse a Ticket/Gift Certificate Customer for any failures, owing to a malfunction of the Ticketing System or a temporary lack of connection to the Ticketing System, which prevent the Ticket/Gift Certificate Customer from purchasing a Ticket or a Gift Certificate. In the event of technical failures, the Promoter undertakes to restore performance as soon as possible.

5.6. A Ticket/Gift Certificate Customer shall be liable in accordance with the current law of the Russian Federation for any consequences of the provision of incorrect or misleading information to the Promoter or a third party representing the Promoter, as well as for the violation of the rights and interests of other persons, resulting from such actions.

5.7. The Parties shall be released from responsibility for a failure to perform and (or) improper performance of their obligations under this Offer, in the event of circumstances beyond reasonable control (force majeure). The occurrence of force majeure must be confirmed by an official document issued by the relevant state body or organisation confirming the fact of occurrence of the events that are circumstances beyond reasonable control.

5.8. A Ticket/Gift Certificate Customer/Ticket Holder cannot, without the written consent of the Promoter, resell, transfer (for commercial or other personal gain) or distribute any Ticket(s)/Gift Certificates (above the Face Value written on the Ticket/Gift Certificate) or buy, or purchase Ticket(s) or Gift Certificates from/or through a reseller who is not the Promoter or not a Promoter's authorised agent.

5.9. The Promoter shall not be responsible for stolen or counterfeit Tickets or Gift Certificates purchased or obtained from unauthorised sources. A Ticket Holder found to be in possession of a counterfeit Ticket reported as lost or stolen will be denied entry to Sochi Autodrom.

A Gift Certificate Holder found to be in possession of a counterfeit Gift Certificate, the Promoter, or an authorised agent of the Promoter has the right to withdraw such Gift Certificate without exchanging it for a Ticket and without returning the face value of the Gift Certificate.

5.10. Tickets or Gift Certificates may not be used for advertising, promotional or commercial purposes including prizes, competitions, contests or sweepstakes, except with the written consent of the Promoter.

5.11. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to (or eject from) Sochi Autodrom any Ticket Holder who is in possession of a Ticket which has been sold,

redeemed or used in a manner which does not comply with the terms and conditions of the Offer.

5.12. It is prohibited to use the name of each of the Daily (as well as abbreviations or translation to a foreign language), the logo or graphic device of the Promoter, the circuit, any of the activities as part of the services provided at Sochi Autodrom or related to Sochi Autodrom for any commercial purposes. The Promoter's trade marks cannot be used without a prior written consent of the Promoter.

5.13. Each Ticket Holder shall compensate the Promoter and/or the Affiliates for any and all damage, loss, liability or injury that they suffer as a result of the Ticket Holder' failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the Offer or the wilful, reckless or negligent acts or omissions of the Ticket Holder, or any person under the Ticket Holder's care, guidance or supervision at Sochi Autodrom.

5.14. Each Ticket Holder must not without the prior written consent of the Promoter:

(a) be at Sochi Autodrom outside of the period of the Daily Activity for which he/she has purchased a Ticket;

(b) leave Sochi Autodrom other than through a designated exit;

(c) remove any fence or cordoned off area, or interfere with any activity undertaken in any fenced off area;

(d) erect any structure, or erect or display any sign or banner etc. at Sochi Autodrom;

(e) post, stick or place any poster, placard, bill, banner print, paper or any advertising material on any building, structure, fence, tree or barrier at Sochi Autodrom;

(f) distribute any printed or visual matter or distribute, display or promote any advertising or promotional material, samples of goods or services or any other matter or thing at Sochi Autodrom;

(g) distribute, hawk, sell, offer or expose for sale any goods or services or collect money or orders for goods and services at Sochi Autodrom;

(h) sell, offer or make available for sale any Ticket/Gift Certificate above its Face Value, indicated in the Ticket/Gift Certificate;

(i) misuse, deface, damage, or tamper with any building, seat, chair, table, structure, vehicle, vessel, truck, pipe, tap, tap-fitting, conduit, electrical equipment, wiring, or signs at Sochi Autodrom;

(j) block any thoroughfare to Sochi Autodrom;

(k) deposit litter, except in a receptacle provided for that purpose;

(l) throw or kick any stone, bottle or other projectile;

(m) disrupt, interrupt or behave in any manner that may disrupt or interrupt any race, event or activity;

(n) act or conduct oneself in such a way as to hinder, obstruct or interfere with a driver of any vehicle, any vehicle taking part in a race or to adversely affect the safety of the public;

(o) use indecent or obscene language or threatening or insulting words or otherwise behave in a threatening, riotous, indecent or insulting manner;

(p) operate or use a loud hailer, public address system, broadcast device or other device which may interfere with electronic or radio communications being used by the Promoter, the Affiliates, Activity participants or other persons authorised by the Promoter;

(q) smoke outside the designated areas;

(r) get to a grandstand or other areas at Sochi Autodrom with beverages in plastic, glass or metal containers (with a volume extending 0.5 ltr.), except for plastic or paper cups, purchased at the designated sales points located at Sochi Autodrom.

5.15. A Ticket Holder acknowledges that, to the extent to which such Ticket Holder participates in: (a) a sporting, race activity or similar leisure time pursuit; and/or (b) an activity that involves a significant degree of physical exertion or physical risk; and/or (c) is undertaken for the purposes of recreation, enjoyment or leisure, including any activity, participation in various amusements and interactive displays, the Promoter does not give any warranty that the services will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the Activities will be fit for the purposes for which they are supplied.

5.16. The Promoter reserves the right, without notice, to add, remove, substitute any team or personality, participating in the Daily Activities, to amend seating arrangements and audience capacity, whether announced or not. The Promoter is not liable to a Ticket Holder for any changes in the participants or format of, or any other element of the Daily Activities. The Promoter is not liable to a Ticket Holder for any loss or damage, whether direct or indirect, that is incurred as a result of any types of the Daily Activities (or any part of them) being cancelled, postponed or changed. Refunds for Tickets are carried out in accordance with clause 9 of this Offer.

5.17. One Ticket is valid for one person only (except for the right to enter with the Ticket Holder for excursion services for free for children under 6).

5.18. When several Tickets that are assigned to physical seats in a grandstand of Sochi Autodrom are purchased in one order, the Promoter does not guarantee the provision of seats next to each other (in one row in succession).

5.19. The Promoter is not responsible for activities and services provided by third parties at the Sochi Autodrom circuit, as well as for services in respect of which the Promoter acts as an agent.

5.20. Pit Stop Challenge is potentially dangerous, as a special tool with rotating parts is used for it, as well as car wheels weighing more than 5 kg. A Pit Stop Challenge participant agrees with this and takes full responsibility for his/her health upon himself/herself.

6. INFORMATION SENDOUT

6.1. By accepting this Offer, a Ticket/Gift Certificate Customer agrees that the Promoter or any third party acting with consent of the Promoter may regularly distribute information, regarding the services provided at Sochi Autodrom under this

Offer, other services held at Sochi Autodrom (such as the FORMULA 1 VTB RUSSIAN GRAND PRIX) and/or any other Promoter's offers to the e-mail address and/or mobile phone number indicated by the Ticket/Gift Certificate Customer while purchasing the Ticket/Gift Certificate.

6.2. The volume and content of the information distributed as well as the dates and times of the distribution shall be established by the Promoter in its absolute discretion.

6.3. A Ticket/Gift Certificate Customer shall have the right, at any time to opt out of such communications by sending an email notification to the Promoter according to the instructions, contained in the corresponding letter (newsletter).

6.4. The provisions of clauses 6.1. to 6.3. of this Offer apply to Ticket/Gift Certificate Customers who are not citizens of the countries of the European Union in full. For Ticket/Gift Certificate Customers who are citizens of the European Union, the provisions of this clause apply to the extent that they do not contradict the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation.

7. ADDITIONAL SERVICES

7.1. The Promoter or a third party acting with the permission of the Promoter shall have the right to charge a Ticket/Gift Certificate Customer additional payments related to the delivery of the Ticket/Gift Certificate, bank charges, service charges and services related to the purchase of the Ticket/Gift Certificate. The Ticket Customer confirms the acceptance of additional payments (indicated on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website or other Internet resource specified on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website, in the Official Ticket Offices or via the call centre) when placing the order.

7.2. Each Ticket Customer who chooses Ticket courier delivery service shall solely bear all courier, delivery and/or postal charges incurred in relation or ancillary thereto, unless otherwise provided for by the Promoter's offer.

7.3. An address for the delivery must be provided at the time of booking the Ticket and the Ticket Customer or its duly authorised representative must be available to sign for and receive the Ticket during the hours of courier delivery.

7.4. Changes to the delivery address details, including the email address, may only be made by contacting the Official Call Centre. It is the sole responsibility of the Ticket Customer who has purchased the Ticket to notify the Promoter of any changes prior to the Ticket being dispatched.

7.5. The Promoter or a third party authorised by it shall not be responsible for any Tickets lost or misplaced by the courier company or postal service.

7.6. Unless otherwise stated, the Ticket prices do not include the cost of goods and services not related to admission to Sochi Autodrom.

8. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

8.1. A Ticket Holder may make, create, store, record or transmit any kind of sound recording, visual footage, audio-visual footage (further - Recordings), as well as store, record or transmit any information or other data in relation to the services provided at Sochi Autodrom. It is allowed to bring into Sochi Autodrom any equipment designed to perform the aforementioned acts unless otherwise agreed with the Promoter. Electronic devices (including still image cameras, mobile telephones and other handheld personal communication devices) are permitted within Sochi Autodrom unless otherwise advised, provided that any Recordings, Data and any image, including photographic images and any still pictures derived or capable of being derived from a Recording (further - Image), recorded, stored and/or created at Sochi Autodrom are used for personal and non-commercial purposes only, which does not include social media. But creating content for subsequent posting in the media or blog without prior agreement with the Promoter is prohibited.

8.2. A Ticket Holder hereby agrees that:

(a) he/she can be held liable for any use of such Recordings, Data and Images, listed in Clause 8.1. of the Offer for advertising, commercial or other purposes (except for private viewing) without a prior written consent of the Promoter;

(b) upon the request of the Promoter the Ticket Holder shall assign to the Promoter in writing the copyright and all other intellectual property rights in any Image or Recording that the Ticket Holder creates, makes, stores or records;

8.3. During the racing types of the Daily Activities the noise level may be very high. It is advised to wear hearing protection during the provision of the services to reduce the risk of hearing damage.

8.4. A Ticket Holder acknowledges and accepts that some seats have restricted viewing or legroom and that natural or man-made obstructions in some areas may impede viewing. The Promoter reserves the right at its discretion to issue changes to seating arrangements if allocated immediately before the start of the provision of the services, which may result in a Ticket Holder being moved to a seat with an obstructed view or restricted legroom. Should the Promoter issue any significant changes, the Promoter will notify the Ticket Holder directly of such changes and endeavour to provide alternative seating arrangements.

8.5. By entering Sochi Autodrom, a Ticket Holder grants their consent to the Promoter using their image obtained by taking photographs and/or filming. The Promoter (and any third party authorised by the Promoter from time to time) may use for the purposes of or in connection with any publication, exhibition or broadcast (including any advertising or promotional literature, campaign or material) in any media worldwide approved by the Promoter any still or moving images taken at Sochi Autodrom where such image includes any image of the Ticket Holder and the Ticket Holder waives any and all of his or her personality and privacy rights to the extent necessary to permit such use.

8.6. During a Mercedes test drive as part of the AMG Experience project, the Ticket Holder (the test drive participant/passenger) is warned that participation is associated with an increased risk to his/her health/life as the participant (passenger) and to the health/life of third parties, that participation is voluntary, that the participant

(passenger) is aware of his/her qualification and driving experience and confirms that he/she assumes responsibility for his/her own safety and the safety of those who are in the car, if there is damage to the car, health and/or property of third parties through the participant fault, the participant is liable for all the damage caused by him or a person accompanying him in full.

9. TICKET REFUND AND REPLACEMENT PROCEDURE

9.1. A Ticket Customer may request a refund in the following cases:

(a) Cancellation of any service provided at Sochi Autodrom.

(b) Death of the Ticket Customer.

(c) Sickness of the Ticket Customer not allowing him or her to visit Sochi Autodrom and/or use the services provided at Sochi Autodrom for medical reasons.

(d) In any other cases provided for by the law of the Russian Federation.

9.2. A refund shall not exceed the face value of the Ticket purchased.

Additional payments will not be refunded in case of a Ticket refund on the grounds provided for in Sub-clauses b to d Clause 9.1. of this Offer.

9.3. In case of the cancellation or postponement of the services provided at Sochi Autodrom by decision of state authorities, the Promoter has the right to exchange the Ticket of the Ticket Customer for any Daily Activity chosen by the Ticket Customer.

9.4. If the full face value of a Gift Certificate or its part is not used during the period specified in the Gift Certificate, the Gift Certificate becomes invalid. When using a Gift Certificate for an amount less than its stated value, the balance cannot be refunded and can only be used to purchase a Ticket Product (except for a Gift Certificate).

9.5. Only the Ticket Customer may request a refund for this Ticket, and in cases provided for in Clause 9.1. (b) and (c) of the Offer also his/her legal representative or other duly authorised person.

9.6. To obtain a refund for a Ticket purchased from a Designated Seller, the Customer shall follow the relevant Ticket refund procedure implemented by this Designated Seller.

9.7. To obtain a refund for a Ticket purchased on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website or at the Official Ticket Offices, the Ticket Customer can contact the Official Call Centre on 8 800 100 46 86, +7 (495) 197 77 26 (for international calls), or send the set of documents required to the Organiser ANO "ROSGONKI" at 26 Triumphalnaya St., Sochi 354340, Krasnodar Region (by courier), P.O. Box 230, Sochi 354340 (by post), or email it to the Organiser at callcenter@rosgonki.ru.

A sample of the Ticket refund request is available on the [Sochi Autodrom Official Website](#), at the Official Ticket Offices or by contacting the Organiser at callcenter@rosgonki.ru. The request should contain the bank details of the account to which the Ticket refund should be made. All the fields of the Ticket refund request form should be filled out.

The following should be attached to the Ticket refund request:

– a copy of the electronic Ticket;

- original receipt or its copy, proving that the purchase was made at the Official Ticket Offices or online on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website;
- a copy of the Ticket Customer;
- documents in confirmation of the fact of the death or the sickness of the Ticket Customer.

9.8. In case the Promoter agrees to refund the Ticket, the money shall be returned to the Ticket Customer as follows:

- a) If the Ticket was paid for on or before 05/08/2020:
 - by cash or using a non-cash payment method, the refund will be remitted to the bank details which the Ticket Customer indicates in the relevant refund request form;
- b) If the Ticket was paid for after 05/08/2020:
 - using a non-cash payment method (bank card) at a ticket office or on the website, the refund will be remitted to the bank details, which was used for purchasing the Ticket, or to the bank details which the Ticket Customer indicates in the relevant refund request form;
 - by cash, the refund will be performed at a ticket office where the Ticket was purchased or remitted to the bank details which the Ticket Customer indicates in the relevant refund request form.

The refund is processed within 10 (ten) calendar days of the receipt of a refund request and all the necessary documents and information by the Promoter, unless other term is set by the norms of the current law of the Russian Federation.

9.9. The Promoter reserves the right to deny the refund of a Ticket if the Ticket has been purchased in violation of the Terms and Conditions of the Offer.

9.10. In case of loss/damage (inability to use, including by another person) of a Ticket, the Customer may print the Ticket or go to an Official Ticket Office to do so.

9.11. If a Ticket is stolen, the Customer shall have the right to go to an Official Ticket Office to have the Ticket re-issued. The Ticket Customer will be denied the re-issue if it is determined that by the time of the request this Ticket has been scanned for entry and is inside Sochi Autodrom.

10. GIFT CERTIFICATES

10.1. Gift Certificates shall be refunded in accordance with the law of the Russian Federation.

10.2. A Gift Certificate is valid for 1 (one) year of its purchase. A Gift Certificate cannot be extended.

10.3. A Gift Certificate does not grant the right to visit Sochi Autodrom.

10.4. A Gift Certificate allows to use its full face value or part of it when redeeming it against a Ticket (except for a Gift Certificate).

10.5. In order to redeem a Gift Certificate against a Ticket, the Gift Certificate Holder can redeem the gift certificate against the Ticket himself/herself on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website, or contact the call centre or visit one of the Official Ticket Offices (the list of which is available on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website) to redeem the Gift Certificate against the Ticket.

10.6. When purchasing a Gift Certificate with a face value, the Gift Certificate can be redeemed against a Ticket for any Daily Activity subject to the availability of Tickets for the Daily Activity chosen.

10.7. Gift Certificates can be partially redeemed. The difference between the cost of a Gift Certificate and a Ticket cannot be returned when redeeming the Gift Certificate against a Ticket of lower value and can be used to purchase a Ticket. A Gift Certificate Customer/Holder has the right to redeem the Gift Certificate against a Ticket, the cost of which is higher than the cost of the Gift Certificate, subject to paying the difference between the value of the Gift Certificate and the Ticket.

10.8. If the face value of the Gift Certificate is not enough to purchase the Ticket selected (except for a Gift Certificate) it is possible to pay the extra in cash or by card.

10.9. If the full balance of a Gift Certificate or its part is not used during the period specified in the Gift Certificate, this balance is not refunded.

11. SECURITY PROVISION

11.1. In order to ensure public safety, the Promoter reserves the right to eject the Ticket Holder from Sochi Autodrom at any moment for security reasons. Access to Sochi Autodrom is forbidden after the end of the services provided at Sochi Autodrom.

11.2. To ensure security whilst at Sochi Autodrom, CCTV cameras are used. A Ticket Holder agrees that footage taken of him/her for general security measures may be used for the purposes of general security or passed to the police for use in any proceedings.

11.3. To ensure security whilst at Sochi Autodrom the Promoter reserves the right to search any person entering Sochi Autodrom and any of his/her belongings without giving any reasons, as well as the right to refuse entry to Sochi Autodrom for any person or to eject from Sochi Autodrom any person refusing to submit to search. No refund of the Ticket cost will be made in this case.

11.4. No animals will be admitted to Sochi Autodrom or the car parks, except guide dogs.

11.5. While at Sochi Autodrom, Ticket Holders must always keep to the designated paths and access all free-standing viewing areas with caution, using steps or path as appropriate.

11.6. A Ticket Holder cannot bring into Sochi Autodrom and use the following items:

(a) weapons of any type including self-defence weapons, ammunition, bladed articles, any other items that might be used as a weapon, explosives, poisonous, toxic or odorous substances, radioactive materials;

(b) flammable and pyrotechnical substances or articles, (except for matches, pocket lighters), including air-horns, flares, fireworks, gas tanks, and any other items (chemicals) that might be used for production of pyrotechnic products or smokes;

(c) other substances, items, articles, including self-made that can be used to produce smoke or fire, self-igniting liquids;

(d) tools and articles including self-made that are not pyrotechnical and that are

used for dispersion or diffusion of different substances (pneumatic crackers);

(e) any flag or banner with dimensions exceeding 2.0 x1.5 m, including those with hollow flagpoles with flagpoles' length exceeding 1.5 m and flagpoles' diameter exceeding 2.5 cm, chairs, benches, stools, ice chests, helium filled balloons, balls of any type and size;

(f) colourants;

(g) wind instruments to produce sounds (including vuvuzelas and whistles), except for bugles and pipes;

(h) alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks of any kind, except for soft drinks in plastic containers with the volume not exceeding 0.5 litres, glass bottles or containers, food, except for baby food with the volume not exceeding 1 litre per baby (including soy milk, breast milk or cow's milk, infant formulas and sterilized water, including those in glass containers, any other food, required for feeding children under 5 years of age);

(i) narcotics, toxics or stimulants;

(j) promotional extremist materials; materials containing Nazi or extremist symbols or attributes;

(k) technical equipment which can interfere with the staging of the services provided at Sochi Autodrom or with their participants (laser devices, flashlights), radios, sound amplification tools;

(l) bulky items that create inconvenience for other spectators, except with the consent of the organiser of an official sports competition to bring such items;

(n) bicycles, scooters, skateboards and roller blades, fireworks, frisbees, musical instruments and (or) musical equipment, including alarm systems, sirens, whistles, electronic equipment or any other broadcast equipment;

(o) kick scooters, including two- or three-wheeled, self-balancing electric vehicles (e.g. Segway);

(p) suitcases or bags with the dimensions exceeding 40cm x 40cm x 45cm.

12. USE OF CAR PARKS LOCATED AT SOCHI AUTODROM

12.1. All vehicles (and their contents) parked within any car park operated by the Promoter are left at the vehicle owners' sole risk. The Promoter shall not be liable for any loss or damage caused to the owners as a result of their use of a car park located at Sochi Autodrom or in adjacent territories (including damage to the owners' vehicles and/or their contents).

12.2. Vehicle owners and passengers alike must at all times act responsibly and with due safety whilst in the car parks located at Sochi Autodrom (either on foot or when driving).

13. DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROCEDURE

13.1. Any dispute arising out of the explanation or implementation of this Offer will be resolved by the Parties by sending a complaint to the other Party. The complaint shall be considered within 10 working days of its receipt.

13.2. If the Parties do not reach an agreement, the dispute shall be resolved in the court of general jurisdiction or in the arbitration court of Moscow.

14. FINAL PROVISIONS

14.1. This Offer shall commence and become operative on 06 August 2020.

14.2. The Promoter has a right to make changes to this Offer at any time. All changes shall be published and brought to public attention by publication on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website at https://sochiautodrom.ru/Documents/Offer_Daily_activities_2020_en.pdf. Changes to the Offer do not have a retroactive effect, which means they are not applicable to civil law relations that emerged before the publication of the changes.

14.3. The Promoter has the right to terminate the Offer at any time without prior notice to the Ticket Product/Gift Certificate Customer/Holder in case of violation of the terms and conditions of the Offer by the latter.

14.4. The amendments or variations of the terms and conditions of this Offer are only valid and binding if made or confirmed by the Promoter by publishing a notice on the Sochi Autodrom Official Website.

14.5. Each of the provisions of this Offer is severable from any other. If any provision or part of a provision is or becomes invalid, unenforceable or illegal in any respect, such provision or part of such provision will be deemed invalid and will be deemed not to form part of this Offer. The remaining provisions or parts of such provisions will not be deemed invalid.

14.6. The terms and conditions of the Offer have been drawn up in the Russian and English languages. In the event of any inconsistency between the Russian and English versions, the Russian version of the Offer shall prevail.

14.7. The terms and conditions of the Offer are governed by, construed and enforced in all respects in accordance with the law of the Russian Federation.
